Description

It should be possible to add external identifiers at various places in the schema, to uniquely reference an element, e.g. besides the name, also add the ORCID ID of a person. Other examples could be GeoID, TaxonID, ScientificNameID, etc.

In ABCD it would be possible to have this either as a repeatable element or an attribute (compare to country or language). Adding an URI instead of/additionally to a String containing the name of the element is also an important feature in the context of Linked Open Data (LOD)
